

DABBERS 2 DAY SUMMER TRIAL

Ashdon, Essex.

On Saturday afternoon, there will be a trial starting at 1:00 PM. This will be for twinshocks, pre-70s and guests with 2 routes as normal, but it will be run as a light-hearted team trial. Teams will consist of 4 riders maximum with the best 3 scores counting towards the overall team score. It would help the organisers if you could "register" your teams by email to contact@dabberstrialsclub.co.uk before the event by sending the names of riders along with a team name. Please don't send any money, just fill in the usual entry form (available on www.dabberstrialsclub.co.uk) and sign on as a team on the day. If you can't pre-register, don't worry, you can do it all on the day but it would be a big help if you can. We will also make up teams on the spot to make sure that individuals get to ride the trial too. After the trial, we will set up a fun time and observation section. The idea is to raise money by riders donating and competing for a prize. You can have as many goes as you like to get the fastest, dab free score. On Saturday evening, after the trial there will be a presentation for the winning team followed by this season's Dabbers Trials Club championship presentations.
