

DABBERS NEW YEAR TRIAL LITTLE LODGE FARM, SANTON DOWNHAM INFORMATION

Little Lodge Farm is the “home” of the Dabbers Trials Club. It all started here a long time ago with a few members of the Vintage Motorcycle Club holding conducted trials for old bikes. Roy, the land owner is a keen motorcyclist and his son Jeff is an expert trials rider – one time eastern centre champion.

TRIAL FORMAT

The format of the New Year trial is a little different in that it starts at 10:00 (half an hour earlier than usual) and there will be one easy route. There’s no break for lunch halfway through, but once the trial is over, you can swap your rider number card for food from the hog roast.

We have secured the use of some additional Forestry Commission land for this trial to enable us to set up additional varied sections.

The Forestry Commission fees and hog roast cost require us to increase the entry fee to £15 for this event.

PRE-REGISTRATION

You must pre-register for all Dabbers events. You can do this by emailing us giving your name, make of bike, class (Rigid, Pre-70, Twinshock, Sidecar or Mono) and route (Dabbers, 50/50 or Expert).

DIRECTIONS

Entrance to the farm is on the B1107, 2 miles from Brandon and 2.5 miles from the A11 Thetford bypass at the Santon Downham junction. Look out for Dabbers signs. Postcode for your sat nav **IP27 0TX**

Note: some sat navs seem to send you over a non-existent river crossing! Remember that the farm entrance is off the B1107 and you will be OK.
