

CHARITY TRIAL AT STOWBRIDGE FARM, STRETHAM, NR ELY - INFORMATION

Stowbridge Farm is a large working farm specialising in potato growing. Around the farm there are several areas of woodland, ditches and banks that are ideal for our sport. The lap of sections includes a ride around some of the farm. The “going” here is typical fenland rich soil, so things can get a bit slippery if it’s wet.

TRIAL FORMAT

The event starts at 10:00. Signing on from 9:00. Rider briefing at 09:55.
There will be approximately 20 sections, 2 laps with a lunch break at about 12:30.

This event is being run to raise some cash for Cancer Research UK. The farm owner, Mr Palmer, will donate his land owner fee to the charity and Dabbers Trial Club will add any profits from the event. Additionally, Mr Palmer will provide food for us all during the lunch break, with all proceeds going to the good cause. The jacket spuds should be worth a try as his Maris Piper potatoes were chosen as the best in the country.

DIRECTIONS

Stretham is on the A10, 11 miles north of the A10 /A14 junction at Cambridge. At Stretham roundabout, take the A1123 east into the village. Go through the village and follow the A1123 about ½ mile across the river Ouse, and the farm entrance is on the right before reaching the railway crossing.

BEWARE: There are some large speed ramps on the farm track. Follow Dabbers signs to the parking area.
